Memory Verse: Ephesians 4:25 “Therefore, each of you must put off lies and speak the truth to your neighbor, for we are all members of one body.”



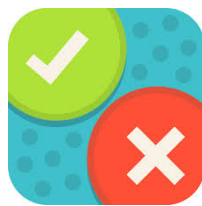
Liar, Liar by Gary Paulsen

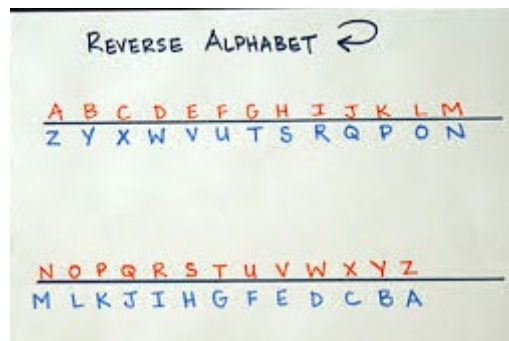

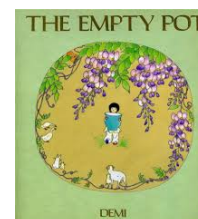
